ROYAL AIRFORCE ENGLISH BREAKFAST

*Makibari Estate in Darjeeling, India and Satemwa Estate, Malawi*  
Traditional British tea at its finest - made as a bespoke blend for a Battle of Britain

EARL GREY

*Satemwa Estate, Malawi and Reggio Calabria, Italy*

LEMON VERBENA

*Provence, France*  
Brought to Europe by the Spanish in the 17th Century. A pure herb with a mellow  
lemon flavour, it makes a wonderful, digestive.

WILD ROOIBOS

*Cederberg Mountains, South Africa*  
This Rooibos is harvested completely wild in its indigenous habitat in the Cederberg  
Mountains. A richly delicious infusion with deep earthy notes, bright red berries and  
cedar can be enhanced with maple syrup & twist of lemon zest.
